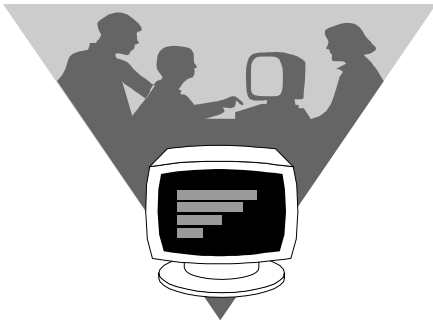
The meeting adjourned at 8:25p.m.
